How ever for proposal of shifting of Thergaon Range in the Pune-IV Division and Chakan Range in the Pune-V Division; they expressed that since there are more export clearances in the presence of Central Excise Officers, those two Ranges may be retained at the places where they function presently. They further informed that they would submit representation in writing with justification for shifting of Ranges functioning at P.J. Chambers and for retention of Thergaon and Chakan Ranges.

The Chairman assured the Members that retention of the above two Ranges would be considered if there are more exports in the presence of C.Ex. Officers.
