3. The Chairman welcomed the members to the meeting.

4. The minutes of the PGC Meeting for the months of Feb,2011 held on 25-02-2011 at 15.30 hrs. were unanimously approved. Accordingly, the Minutes have been adopted.

5. There were no points received in advance except an Office letter F.No. PGC/TA/HR/EOUA dtd. 18-03-2011 submitted by Shri. Harish Radhakrishnan on behalf of 'Association of Export Oriented Units c/o Serum Institute of India, Pune-28'. This letter was regarding shifting of Ranges at P. J. Chambers, Pimpri, Thergaon Range and Chakan Range. A gist of the said submission is that i) there is no problem for shifting of the Ranges in the P.J. Chambers to Akurdi Complex as long as neat place with adequate arrangements for Assessee to meet the Range Officers is provided and ii) Thergaon Range and Chakan Range may please be retained at the present locations for the ease of operation of Trade in as much as lot of units in those areas are in Software Export business/ normal exporters.

S/Shri Rajan Mudbidri and Narendra Adawadkar raised an issue of retention of Thergaon Range and submitted the following written submissions during the meeting :-

- i) submission F.No. Nil dtd. 24-02-2011 signed by total 31 Nos of Units such as M/s Emcure Pharmaceuticals(100%)EOU, Virgo Engineers, Tata Autocomp Systems Ltd., Kirpekar Engineering P.Ltd. etc.etc.
- ii) submission F.No. Nil dtd. 25-02-2011 from M/s. Honeywell Turbo Technologies (India) P. Ltd. Village Mann , Pune-57
- iii) submission F.No. Ni dtd. 24-02-2011 from M/s. Saertex India Pvt. Ltd. Village Mann, Pune-57

iv) M/s. KPIT Cummins Infosystems Ltd. (Unit - IV), Hinjewadi, Pune-57.

A gist of these submissions is that Thergaon Range may please be retained at the present location due to many reasons such as there are lot of 100% EOU, STP units. The activity involves export sealing, issue of duty free certificates, re-ware housing certificates, verifications, for these activities they have to approach Range office, distance of the Hinjewadi to present Range Office is 11 Km. while that up to Akurdi is 18 Km etc. and hence Thergaon Range may please be retained at the present location.

REPLY:

The Chairman replied that i) the Range Offices presently at P.J. Chambers, Pimpri will start functioning from Excise Bhavan, Akurdi from 01-04-2011 onwards and ii) regarding retention of Thergaon Range and Chakan Range at the present locations, the matter will be examined.
